PEACE-BUILDING AND ENVIRONMENTAL CHALLENGES IN WAR-TORN SOCIETIES

KEN CONCA is an associate professor of Government and Politics at the University of Maryland and Director of the Harrison Program on the Future Global Agenda. His research and teaching focus on global environmental politics, social movements, environmental policy, North-South issues, and peace and conflict studies. His latest book, *Governing Water: Contentious Transnational Politics and Global Institution Building* (MIT Press, 2006) recently received two book awards from the International Studies Association: the Chadwick Alger Prize for best book on international organization and the Harold and Margaret Sprout Award for best book on international environmental affairs. Dr. Conca is an associate editor of *Global Environmental Politics* and a member of the scientific steering committee on Global Environmental Change and Human Security (GECHS) of the International Human Dimensions Programme on Global Environmental Change (IHDP).
